<b>4 Purpose of processing the personal data</b>	The purpose of register is compliance with regulation concerning transactions of managers and their closely associated persons in accordance with Article 19 of the market abuse regulation ((EU) No 596/2014) and a regulation complement to it.
<b>5 Data content of register</b>	The following data is registered for the manager and their closely associated persons: - Name - Position - Basis for the closely associated person status - Manager/closely associated person status start date - Contact details (telephone number, e-mail address, postal address) - Transaction notifications received from the registered person and their disclosures
<b>6 Regular sources of information</b>	Manager himself/herself and their closely associated persons, public sources of information, such as the Trade Register and the Business Information System

## REGISTER DESCRIPTION

<p><b>7</b> <b>Regular destinations of disclosed data</b></p>	<p>Data can be disclosed to parties referred to in the Market abuse regulation and regulations based on it, which can be, for example, the Financial Supervisory Authority and the Police.</p>
<p><b>8</b> <b>Regular data transfer to outside of the European Union or the European Economic Area</b></p>	<p>Personal information may be moved outside of the European Union or the European Economic Area as part of the company's ICT infrastructure. If this occurs, the company will make sure that an adequate level of data security is guaranteed as required by law.</p>
<p><b>9</b> <b>Principles in accordance to which the data file is secured</b></p>	<p>A Manual materials The Register is not processed manually.</p> <p>B Data processed through ADP Data processed through an ADP system is stored in compliance with the company's data protection policy (e.g. user names and passwords) so that the data access is only for authorized persons.</p>
<p><b>10</b> <b>Right of access</b></p>	<p>Each person shall have the right of access, after having supplied sufficient search criteria, to the data on himself/herself in the personal data file, or to a notice that the file contains no such data.</p> <p>A person who wishes to have access to the data on himself/herself, as referred to above, shall make a request to this effect to the controller by a personally signed document or personally in the controller's premises, and prove an identity.</p>
<p><b>11</b> <b>Right to demand data rectification</b></p>	<p>Each person shall have the right to demand rectification of erroneous data by submitting such a request to the controller's contact person.</p>
